School Dress Code

Appropriate dress, appearance, proper behavior, and cleanliness are vital to each member of the school community. Wearing inappropriate dress to school can have a negative influence on the educational climate of the school.

Each student, with the advice and counsel of his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) should dress in a manner which is appropriate for school and its related activities. Students dressed modestly will generally have no problems concerning student dress codes.

Students are expected to follow the guidelines below when attending school and/or school related functions:

- Undergarments shall not be exposed at any time.
- Blouses/shirts should be constructed so that the top of the shoulder is covered and is fitted under the arms (halter tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, or bare-shouldered tops will not be allowed).
- Blouses/shirts which expose any portion of the waist, hips, midriff or cleavage are not allowed.
- Skirts and shorts should be worn at an appropriate length for school. (7 inch inseam or longer is acceptable)
- Clothing shall be free of suggestive, racial, or other inappropriate writing, advertisement, or artwork.

Students who are found in violation of the dress code will be required to remain out of class until he/she has changed into appropriate clothing. Repeated violations will result in disciplinary action.
