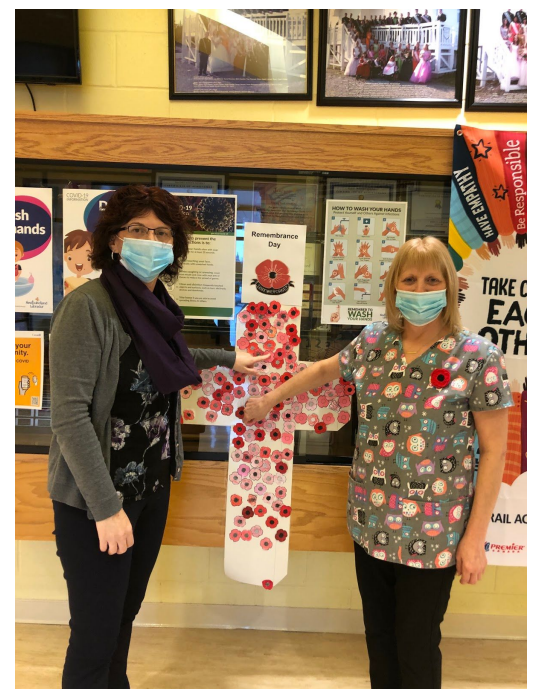


THE GRADE 2 AND 3 CLASS PLACED THEIR POPPIES TO HONOR SOLDIERS AND VETERANS.

Coronavirus virus didn't stop our school from showing their respect on Remembrance Day for our fallen soldiers and for soldiers serving today!

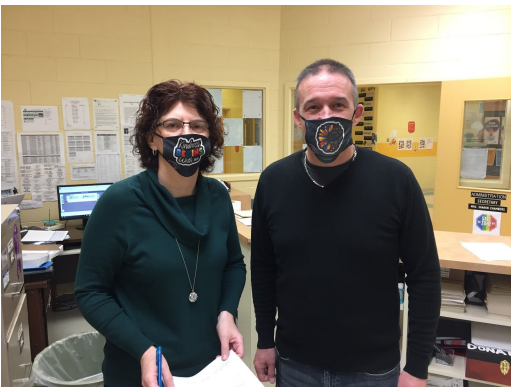
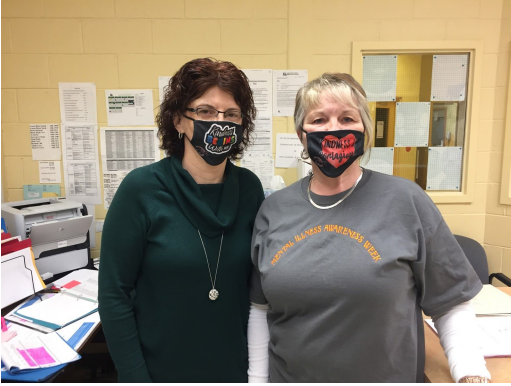


Ms. Sharon and Ms. Nada participated in our annual Remembrance Day Ceremony as well.

November 16 was Pink Day during Kindness Week. These students were wearing pink to remind others to stand up to bullies.

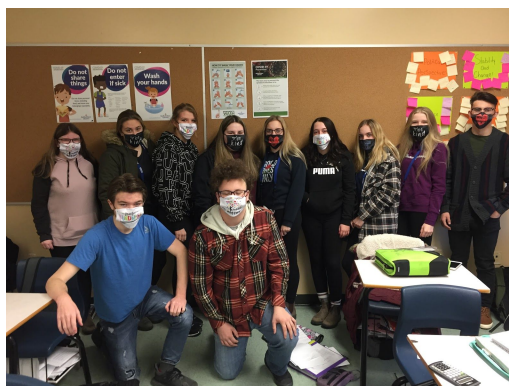
